The volunteers should check the website for applicable fees and restrictions so the members will know what the Transfer Station fees will be based on what they are having picked up. The volunteers will show their VN ID badges to indicate that they are representing Village Neighbors members.

We are working on getting similar services for the residents of Wendell and New Salem.

Great Turnout for 1st Annual Meeting and BBQ

Village Neighbors Annual Meeting and Barbecue was held at the Shutesbury Athletic Club on June 23rd.



68 people attended including 32 members with Nancy Spittle, acting President, facilitating. Nancy acknowledged the loss of our President David Dann and the challenges, rewards and lessons learned since VN launched last October.

Don Stone gave the Treasurer's Report reporting a total income of \$18,345 with \$3335 coming from membership fees, a grant from Life Path providing \$12,218. \$768 was from contributions given in David's memory. Expenses for the year totaled \$14.282.

Nancy Spittle gave the Membership/Volunteer Committee report with their main focus on signing up new members and volunteers and following up with training, vetting, education and support. Goals included developing teams with professional expertise to handle sensitive issues; initiating Dementia Friendly Community features with volunteer training; and encouraging interest groups and activities that promote social opportunities.

Fay Zipkowitz gave the Service Committee report which has been developing policies and procedures and doing fundraising. A new committee for Fundraising has been established.

Mary-Ann Palmieri reported on Call Manager work, answering and filling 3-5 service requests per week.

Paula Lyons and Elizabeth Fernandez O'Brien reported on Public Relations and Event Planning Committees with their focus on increasing awareness of VN in the general community and the media. PR has updated mailing lists, published its first digital newsletter, had a successful fundraiser at the Full Moon Wendell Coffee House and has done outreach to local high schools for volunteers and interns.

Dina Polizzi gave the report for IT. IT's focus this past year was on integrating the database to include volunteer/member interests and providing IT support to the other committees. Projects for next year include developing the website to enhance user-friendliness; training volunteers and members on

website and social media use; and expanding the IT team to help seniors navigate the new technology that broadband will provide.

After the meeting there was a short memorial service for David Dann at the fire pit, led by Dina Stander, where members and friends shared poetry, thoughts and memories. A barbecue with delicious side dishes and desserts was accompanied by music in the pavilion.

Don Stone and Elizabeth Fernandez O'Brien were elected to the Board unanimously.
